Resolution No. 100, Series of 2021

RECOMMENDING THE AWARD OF CONTRACT TO PRINCE MOTOR CORPORATION FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF SEVEN (7) PASSENGER VANS FOR THE PRESIDENTIAL MANAGEMENT STAFF (PMS)

WHEREAS, the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) issued in favor of the PMS an authority to purchase seven (7) passenger vans¹ amounting to PhP18,550,000.00 through Authority to Purchase Motor Vehicles (APMV) no. C-21-0045 dated 14 June 2021 (**Annex A**), which was subsequently approved by the Office of the President through a letter dated 6 August 2021 (**Annex B**);

WHEREAS, the PMS-Building Administration and Transport Service (BATS) submitted to the PMS-Bids and Awards Committee (PMS-BAC) Secretariat the Terms of Reference (TOR) and Purchase Request (PR) for the procurement of the seven (7) passenger vans for the PMS (**Annex C**) with an approved budget for the contract (ABC) amounting to PhP18,550,000.00 (**Annex D**);

WHEREAS, Section 10, Article IV of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (RIRR) of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 9184² provides that all procurement shall be done through Competitive Bidding, except as provided for in Article XVI thereof. In compliance therewith, the PMS-BAC Secretariat posted the Invitation to Bid on the prescribed online platforms³ on 14 July 2021 (**Annex E**), and invited eight (8) prospective bidders via electronic mail to participate in the said procurement project;⁴

WHEREAS, on 22 July 2021, the PMS-BAC Secretariat conducted a pre-bid conference, which was participated in by six (6)⁵ prospective bidders. Only one prospective bidder, the Prince Motor Corporation (PMC), bought the bidding documents on or before 16 September 2021, the deadline set for submission of bids;

WHEREAS, during the Opening of Bids on 16 September 2021, the PMC was declared eligible for having submitted the complete technical, legal, and financial documents. Consequently, its financial component envelope was opened, containing a bid amounting to PhP17,492,216.00, inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees, which is

¹ DBM Budget Circular (BC) No. 2017-1 defines passenger van as a large four-wheel enclosed vehicle intended for conveying passengers and/or hauling cargo, traditionally having four (4) doors (two side doors for the driver and front passengers, a passenger side sliding door, and a tailgate). The seating capacity ranges from eight (8) to 15 passengers, including the driver. It has several rows of folding or removable seats behind the front passenger seat. It has no luggage compartment but an expandable area at the rear which can be used for luggage, cargoes, etc. This type varies from full size to mini-van models.

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well within the ABC, thereby rendering the same as the single calculated bid thereof (**Annex F**), subject to post-qualification;

WHEREAS, per the technical and financial evaluations submitted to the PMS-BAC Secretariat on 11 October 2021⁶ (**Annex G**), the bid⁷ of the PMC was deemed compliant with all the requirements and conditions specified in the Bidding Documents, thereby rendering the same as the **single calculated and responsive bid**;


WHEREAS, the PMS-BAC finds the post-qualification evaluation to be in strict accordance with R.A. No. 9184 and its 2016 RIRR; and,

WHEREAS, Section 12.1(h) of the 2016 RIRR of R.A. No. 9184 mandates that the BAC shall recommend the award of contract to the Head of the Procuring Entity or his/her duly authorized representative.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, **WE**, the Members of the PMS-BAC, hereby **RECOMMEND** to the Deputy Head⁸, the following:

- (1) **AWARD OF CONTRACT** to the Prince Motor Corporation for the supply and delivery of seven (7) passenger vans, amounting to PhP17,492,216.00, inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees; and
- (2) **GRANT OF AUTHORIZATION** to the PMS-BAC Chairperson, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairperson, to sign the Notice of Award and the Notice to Proceed to implement this Resolution.
