Resolution No. 59, Series of 2018

RECOMMENDING THE AWARD OF CONTRACT VIA COMPETITIVE BIDDING TO THE PRONET SYSTEMS INTEGRATED NETWORK SOLUTION, INC. FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF WIFI SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the Information and Communications Technology Service prepared the Terms of Reference (TOR) and purchase request for the procurement of Wifi System, with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) amounting to P4,000,000.00 (**Annex A**), which is included in the Annual Procurement Plan (APP) of the PMS (**Annex B**)¹;

WHEREAS, on 21 June 2018, the PMS-Bids and Awards Committee (PMS-BAC) invited all interested bidders to participate in the competitive bidding for the abovementioned procurement activity² (**Annex C**);

WHEREAS, on 28 June 2018, the PMS-BAC held a pre-bid conference which resulted in the issuance and posting of Bid Bulletin Nos. 10-2018 (**Annex D**) and 10A-2018 (**Annex E**) in the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) on 06 July 2018;

WHEREAS, only the Pronet Systems Integrated Network Solution, Inc. purchased the bid documents and submitted eligibility documents prior to the opening of bids on 13 July 2018;

WHEREAS, during the said opening of bid, the Pronet Systems Integrated Network Solution, Inc. was declared "eligible" by the PMS-BAC for having submitted complete eligibility documents and complied with the specifications as indicated in the TOR (**Annex F**)³. Thus, its financial proposal was opened (**Annex G**);

WHEREAS, the Pronet Systems Integrated Network Solution, Inc.'s offer being the single/lowest calculated bid in the amount of P2,600,000.00 was subjected to post-qualification evaluation in order to determine its compliance and responsiveness to all the requirements and conditions as specified in the Bidding Documents;


³ The PMS-BAC, through its Secretariat, and the technical working group checked the submitted documents of Pronet Systems Integrated Network Solution, Inc. against a checklist of required documents using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criteria, as stated in the Instructions to Bidders pursuant to Section 30.1 and 30.2 of the Revised IRR of R.A. No. 9184.

WHEREAS, per post-qualification evaluation conducted by the BAC Secretariat⁴ and the Technical Working Group⁵, Pronet Systems Integrated Network Solution, Inc. complied with the requirements of the PMS and the law for the said procurement project (**Annex H**).


NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing, **WE**, the members of the PMS-BAC, hereby **RECOMMEND** to the Acting Deputy Head pursuant to Office Order No. 2018-011⁶, the following:

- (1) **AWARD OF CONTRACT** via Competitive Bidding to Pronet Systems Integrated Network Solution, Inc. which submitted the single/lowest calculated and responsive bid for the procurement of wifi system amounting to P2,600,000.00, inclusive of appropriate taxes and fees; and
- (2) **GRANT OF AUTHORIZATION** for the BAC Chairperson to sign the corresponding Notice of Award and Notice to Proceed to implement this Resolution.


