**Resolution No. 65, Series of 2021**

**RECOMMENDING THE AWARD OF CONTRACT TO THE BIGVISION INTERNATIONAL TRADE & INDUSTRIES CORP. FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF DISASTER AND MEDICAL EQUIPMENT FOR THE INTEGRATED OPERATIONS AND SERVICE CONTINUITY SYSTEM (IOSCS) SUBCENTRAL OFFICES (SCOs) IN THE CITIES OF PUERTO PRINCESA, LEGAZPI, AND ILOILO**

**WHEREAS**, the Safety, Wellness, and Resiliency Team (SWeRTe) submitted to the PMS-Bids and Awards Committee (PMS-BAC) the Terms of Reference (ToR) and Purchase Request (PR) for the supply and delivery of disaster and medical equipment<sup>1</sup> for the IOSCS SCOs in the cities of Puerto Princesa, Legazpi, and Iloilo (**Annex A**) with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) in the Updated PMS Annual Procurement Plan for Fiscal Year (FY) 2021, amounting to PhP287,020.00<sup>2</sup> (**Annex B**);

**WHEREAS**, Item No. 8, Annex H of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (RIRR) of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 9184<sup>3</sup> provides that the procuring entity may resort to Small Value Procurement to promote economy and efficiency if the ABC does not exceed PhP1,000,000.00 (**Annex C**);

**WHEREAS**, the PMS-BAC Secretariat posted a request for quotation on August 10, 2021 (**Annex D**) and invited 25 suppliers.<sup>4</sup> Three (3) suppliers<sup>5</sup> responded, but only Bigvision International Trade & Industries Corp. submitted a price quotation within the advertisement period until August 17, 2021.<sup>6</sup> Upon the initial assessment thereof, the PMS-BAC Secretariat found the offer of the Bigvision International Trade & Industries Corp. compliant with the requirements set forth under Item II.F, Appendix A, Annex H of the 2016 RIRR of R.A. No. 9184 (**Annex E**), thus eligible to be evaluated by the end-user;

**WHEREAS**, on August 18, 2021, the SWeRTe forwarded to the PMS-BAC Secretariat its evaluation, stating that the offer of the Bigvision International Trade & Industries Corp. for the supply and delivery of disaster and medical equipment for the IOSCS SCOs in the cities of Puerto Princesa, Legazpi, and Iloilo, amounting to PhP189,600.00, inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees, is compliant with the PMS' terms and conditions in the ToR and well within the ABC, thereby rendering the same as the **single calculated and responsive quotation** (**Annex F**);

**WHEREAS**, the PMS-BAC finds the evaluation/recommendation of the end-user to be in strict accordance with R.A. No. 9184 and its 2016 RIRR; and,

**WHEREAS**, Section 12.1(h), Rule V of the 2016 RIRR of R.A. No. 9184 empowers the BAC to recommend the award of contract to the Head of the Procuring Entity or his/her duly authorized representative.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the foregoing, **WE**, the Members of the PMS-BAC, hereby **RECOMMEND** to the Acting Deputy Head,<sup>7</sup> the following:


- (1) **AWARD OF CONTRACT** to the Bigvision International Trade & Industries Corp. for the supply and delivery of disaster and medical equipment for the IOSC SCOs in the cities of Puerto Princesa, Legazpi, and Iloilo, amounting to PhP189,600.00, inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees; and
- (2) **GRANT OF AUTHORIZATION** to the PMS-BAC Chairperson, or in his absence, the Vice-Chairperson, to sign the Notice of Award and the Notice to Proceed to implement this Resolution.


