PMS-BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE

BID BULLETIN NO. 02-2015

Pursuant to Section 22.5 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 and the agreements reached during the pre-bid conference held last 20 February 2015, the following portions of the Bid Documents are hereby amended, clarified and/or modified relative to the procurement of security services for the PMS, to wit:

1. Schedule of Bidding activities, page 3, which provides:

Activities	Schedule/Time/Venue
4. Submission and Opening of Bids	09 March 2015 (Monday), 10:00 AM , at the 4/F Legal Service Conference Room, PMS Building, Arlegui Street, San Miguel, Manila

- The opening of bids is now set at **9:30 A.M.** of 09 March 2015, while the deadline for the submission of bids is set at **8:30 A.M.**, an hour before the opening.
2. 12.1 (a.3.), Section III: Bid Data Sheet, pages 23-24, which provides: *"Prospective bidders should also submit their respective Tax Clearance per Executive Order 398, Series of 2005, as finally reviewed and approved by the BIR pursuant to GPPB Resolution No. 21-2013."*
 - It should be clarified that the PMS is requiring the submission of, at least, a 2014 tax clearance.
 3. Item 6, Section IV. Technical Specifications (Terms of Reference), page 40, which provides: *"The Service Provider shall also provide one (1) metal walkthrough detector for the main lobby entrance."*
 - Rephrased to read in this wise: *"The Service Provider shall also provide one (1) metal walkthrough detector for the main lobby entrance, which shall be donated to PMS upon the expiration of its contract with the winning bidder"*.
 4. Omnibus Sworn Statement, Section VIII. Bidding Forms, page 49.
 - Pursuant to GPPB Resolution No. 22-2013, the paragraph hereunder should be inserted after item 8(d), the last paragraph, in the Omnibus Sworn Statement, viz:

"9. [Name of Bidder] did not give or pay directly or indirectly, any commission, amount, fee, or any form of consideration, pecuniary or

otherwise, to any person or official, personnel or representative of the government in relation to any procurement project or activity.”

5. Computation of the Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC), Section VIII. Bidding Forms, page 50.

- Pursuant to GPPB Resolution No. 20-2013, prospective bidders should submit their respective NFCCs for the fiscal years 2011, 2012 and 2013.

We remind all participating bidders to adhere to relevant provisions cited in the Bidding Documents and submit those documents pertinent to the procurement at hand.
