**PMS-BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE**

**BID BULLETIN NO. 04-2014**

Pursuant to Section 22.5 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act 9184, the following portions of the Bid Documents are hereby amended, clarified or modified relative to the hiring of consultancy services to design a Competency-Based Capacity Building Program (CBCBP) for PMS, to wit:

1. Number 2 of the ITB Clause 15.1, page 26, provides:

*"The bid security shall be in the following amount:*

1. *P40,000.00, if bid security is in cash, cashier's/manager's check, bank draft/guarantee or irrevocable letter of credit;*
2. *P1000,000.00, if security is in Surety Bond; or*
3. *Any combination of the foregoing proportionate to the share of form with respect to total amount of security."*

We would like inform the prospective bidders that pursuant to GPPB Resolution No. 13-2014<sup>1</sup>, the PMS shall ONLY accept cash, OR cashier's/manager's check in the amount of P40,000.00 (2% of the Approved Budget for the Contract) as bid security for the said procurement project.

2. Section V, page 54, provides for the Terms of Reference (TOR).

Pursuant to the agreements reached during the pre-bid conference on 30 October 2014<sup>2</sup>, the PMS-BAC has revised and modified the TOR accordingly, which is attached herein.

3. We remind all participating bidders to adhere to relevant provisions cited in the Bidding Documents and submit those documents pertinent to the procurement at hand.

<sup>1</sup> Said GPPB Resolution, entitled "Approving Clarification on GPPB Resolution No. 25-2013 With Respect to the Forms of Bid Security that Bidders May Submit During Public Bidding", permits, among other things, the procuring entity to indicate in the Bidding Documents the acceptable forms of bid security that bidders may opt to use, which shall include the Bid Security Declaration provided in Section 27.5 of the Revised IRR, and at least one (1) other form.
